

## Peugeot Pageant 2020-March 27 to 30

## **Expression of Interest**

The next Peugeot Pageant, which the Peugeot Car Club of NSW is hosting, will be held in NSW at Bathurst from Friday 27 March to Monday 30 March 2020. This is two weeks before Easter.

Bathurst is a large historic city of around 44,000 people, about 200km west of Sydney, and probably best known as the home of the October Supercheap 1000 and the Bathurst 12 hour car races.

This form is to advise you of the venue, and to enable you to plan ahead to include the next Pageant in your 2020 itinerary. We have many rooms booked at a central top quality motel. For those who envisage going to the Pageant, we encourage you to both book your own accommodation and definitely advise us of your intention of participating, to assist with catering numbers. There is no commitment by returning your Expression of Interest form to actually attend, but we ask that you let us know if you are thinking of attending.

The format will be similar to most other Pageants commencing with dinner on Friday (cost not included), then concours on Saturday morning, both motorkhana/sporting and fun driving skills events on Saturday afternoon, and observation run on Sunday morning which will end up for lunch at a very large historic house, not too far from Bathurst. This will be followed by an afternoon of free time where you will be able to have a guided tour of the house, or see some of the many other interesting museums etc in or around town. The presentation dinner will be on Sunday night and will conclude with breakfast on Monday morning. All meals will be included from Saturday breakfast to Monday breakfast (inclusive). All breakfasts are only included with our organised motel accommodation, and are a continental buffet breakfast. Friday dinner is not included to allow for late comers, and there is such a huge choice of eateries, depending on your preferences.

You need to book your own accommodation at **Bathurst Heritage Motor Inn**. It has free Wi Fi, reverse cycle air conditioners, guest laundry, a gym with aerobic equipment, complimentary daily newspapers, and Foxtel TV. We are holding some 4 star std motel rooms, which are mainly queen rooms, and some 4½ star deluxe studio rooms which are mainly king rooms. There are also 3 x 4 star heritage cottages (with 2 or 3 brms), which we **aren't** holding, but may be available if you are interested and get in early. Also ask about disabled access rooms, if needed, as there are some available, as are spa suites. Some rooms have shower over bath.

Most rooms have a queen or king and 1 extra bed in them and are very clean and spacious. These will be \$145 per night in a standard motel room incl breakfasts (for 2), or similar in a deluxe room for \$155 (for 2). You will have to talk to Lisa for prices of other room or accommodation configurations. Also ask for a ground floor or first floor room, if this is important for you. Ph 02 6334 3433 (Lisa) and mention the Peugeot Pageant for the special rates. I suggest you book ASAP, as Bathurst is a popular location for visitors. There is also a big pacing event on in Bathurst the weekend of the Pageant and a few days prior to it. Rooms can only be held up to about a month before the start of the Pageant, after which time we cannot be sure of availability. Please book early if you would like additional nights as well.

There is also a caravan park in Bathurst, if you would prefer to do your own thing: NRMA Bathurst Panorama Holiday Park – Ph 02 6331 8286. It is a Big 4 Caravan Park and is about 5km east of Bathurst.

*Please note:* The Pageant registration fee will include all meals except Friday dinner, & breakfasts (incl with our recommended motel booking). The registration form will be available as soon as costs are finalised.
